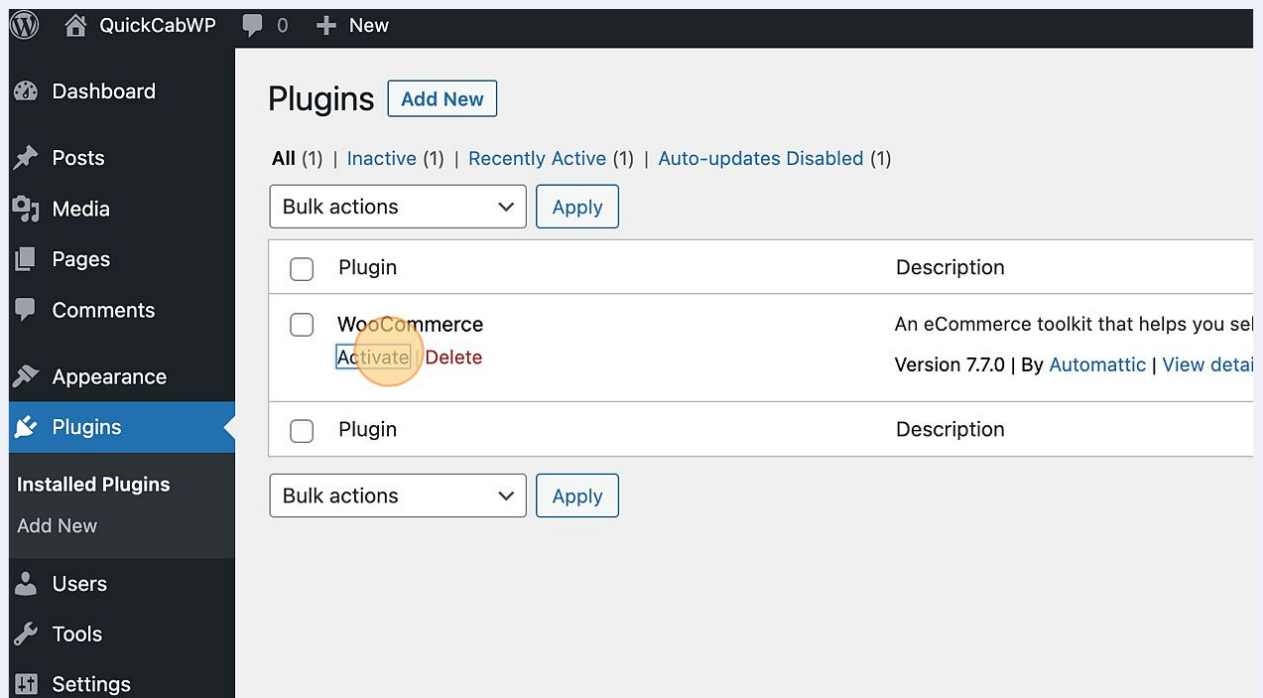



Installation Guide

- 2 Install and activate WooCommerce plugin




3 Click "Add New"
