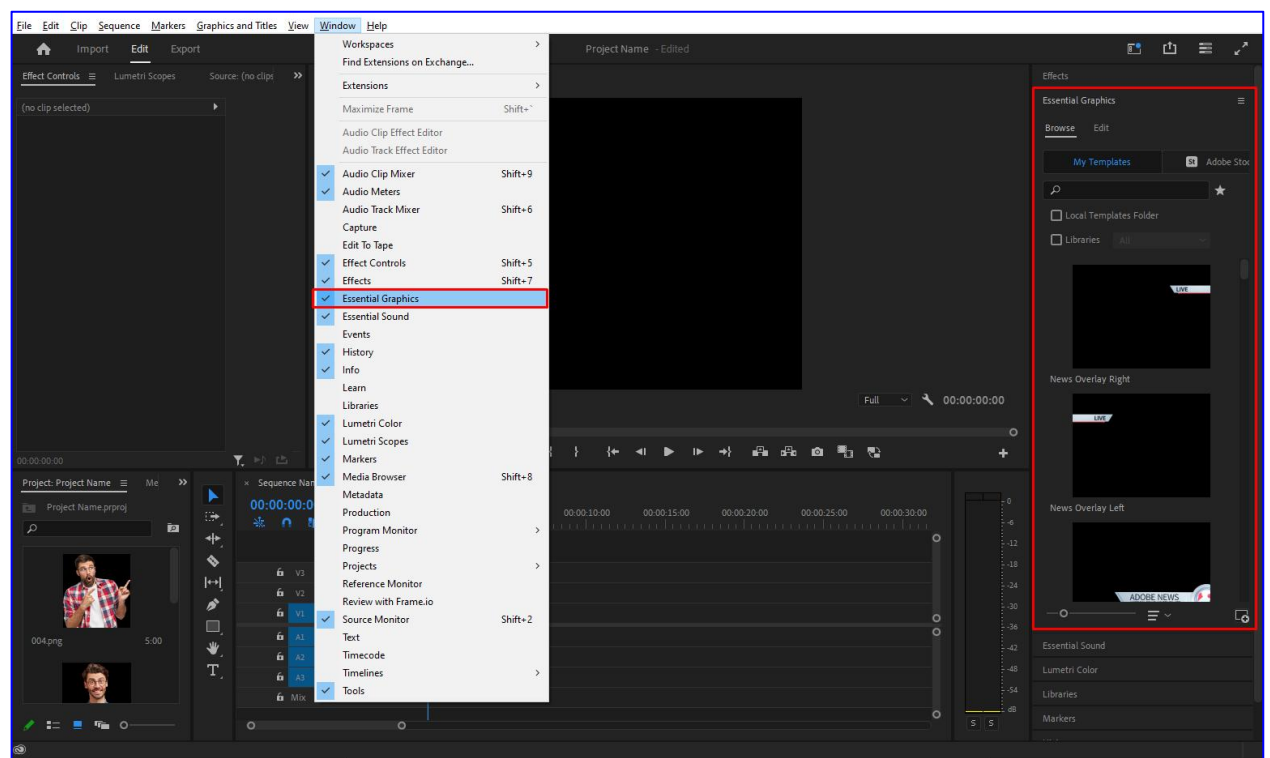
To import and edit MOGRT files in Premiere Pro, follow these steps:

Open Premiere Pro application in your computer.

Click create “New Project” button

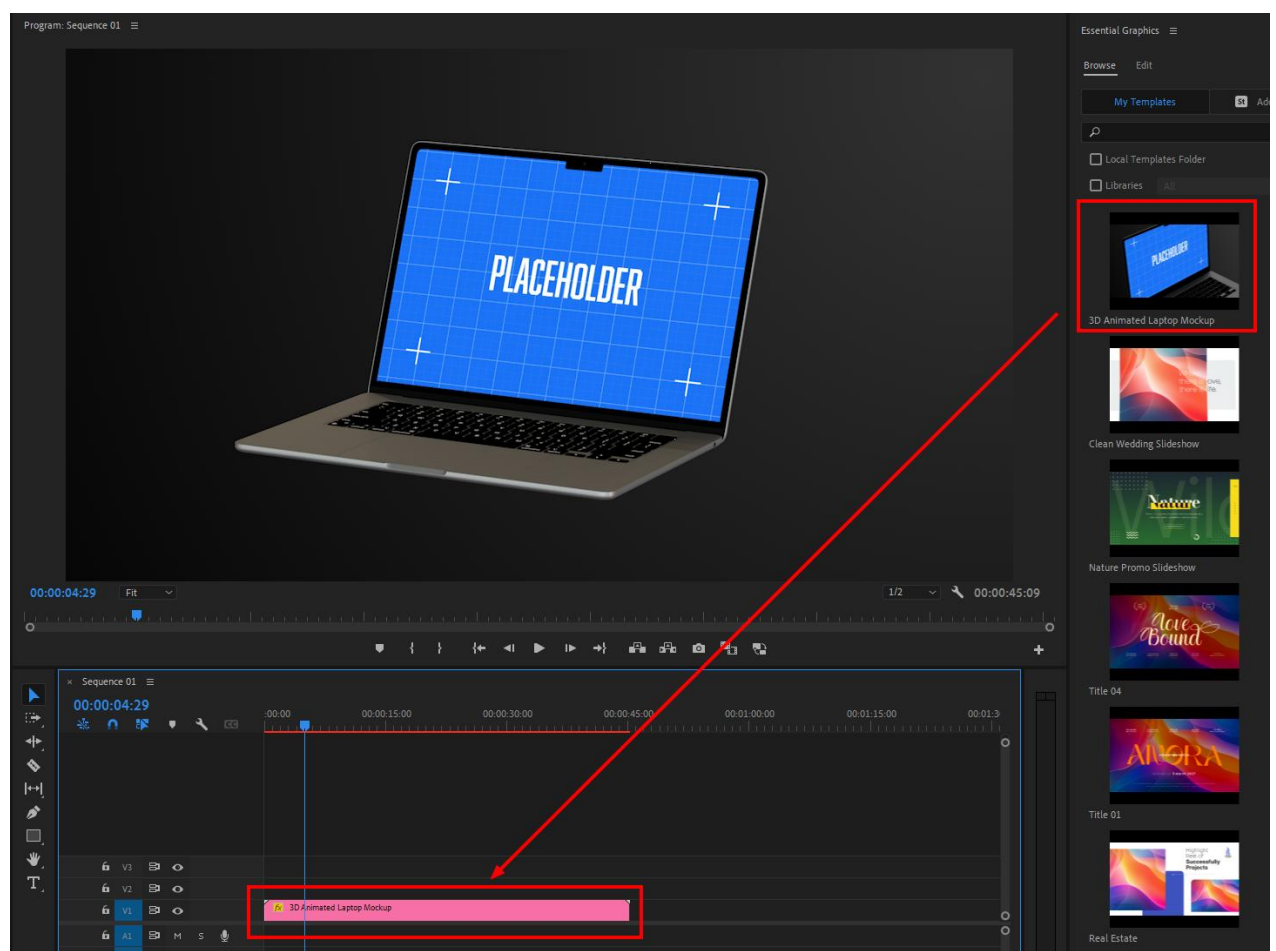
Write your project name and Sequence Name. If you want import media select the media. Then click “Create” button.

Go to Graphics > Essential Graphics.



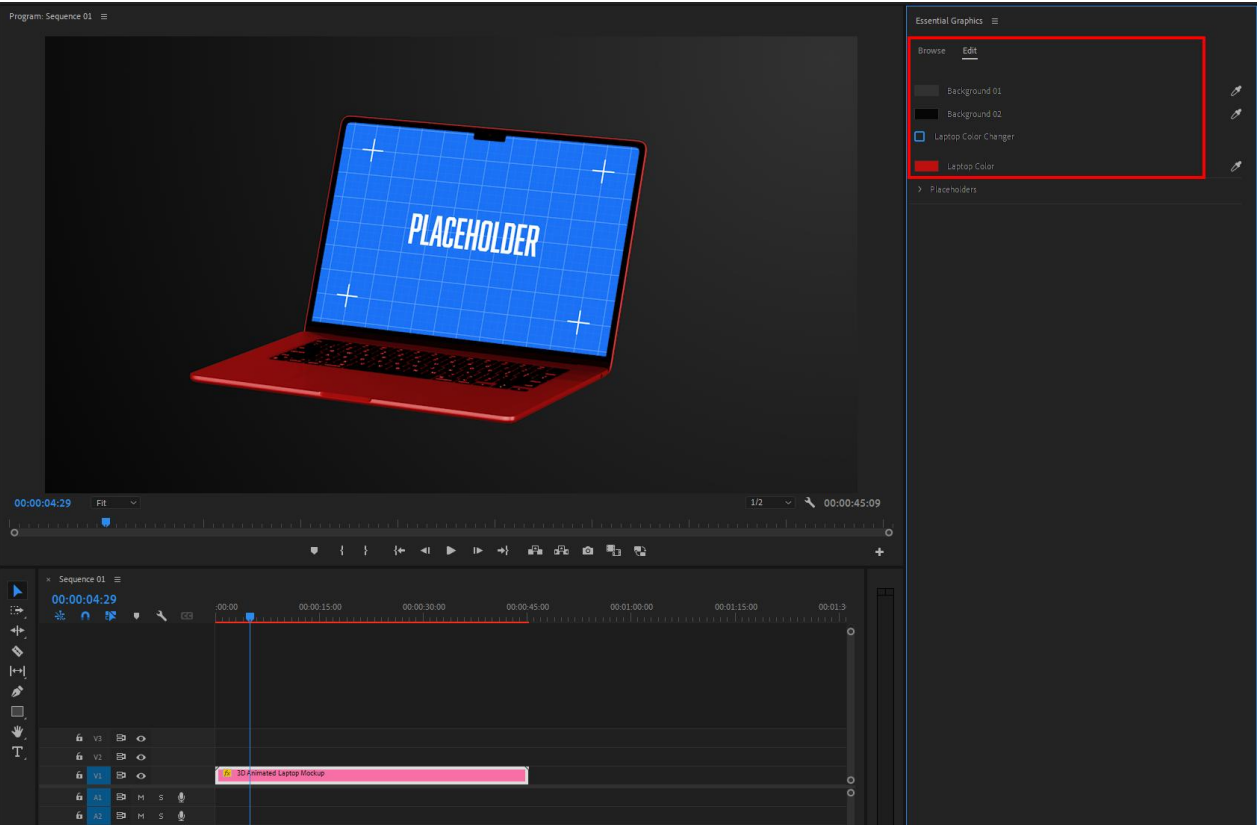
In the Essential Graphics panel, click the + button and select Browse. Navigate to the MOGRT file that you want to import and select it. Click Open. The MOGRT file will be imported into the Essential Graphics panel. To easily find sort by recent.

Then drag into the timeline. Select the “Change sequence setting”.

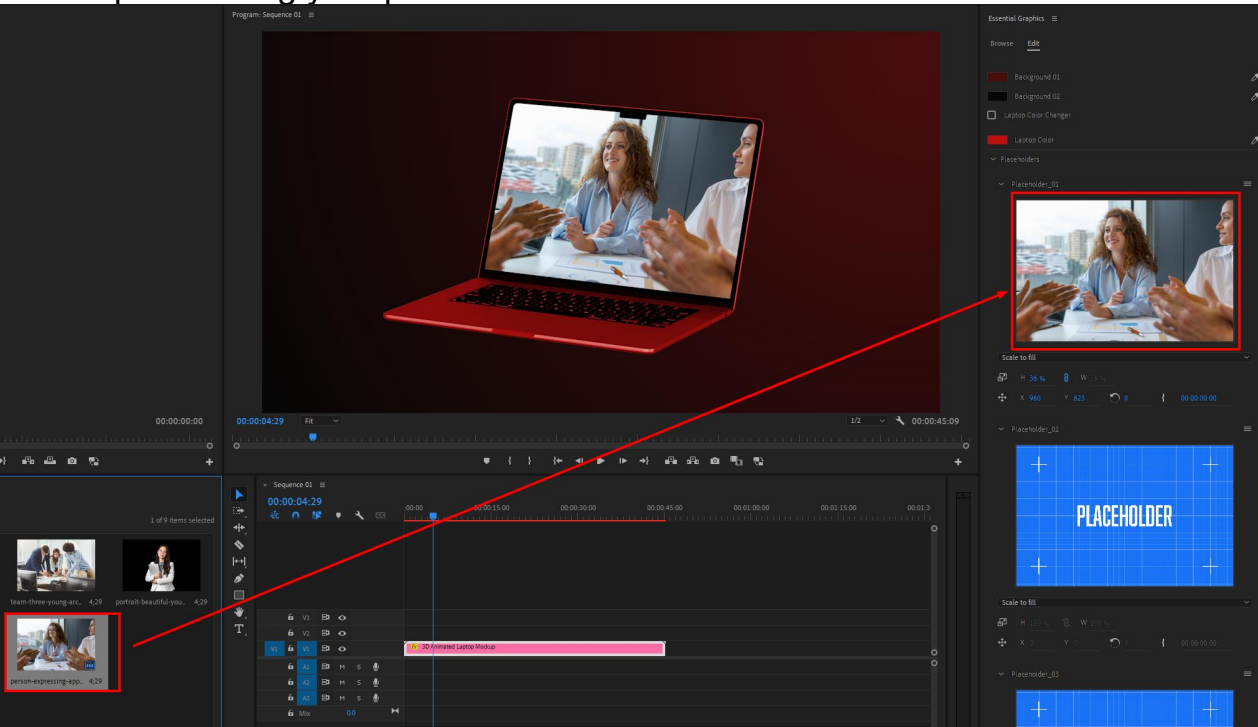


To edit the MOGRT file, double-click on it in the Essential Graphics panel. This will open the Essential Graphics window. In the Essential Graphics window, you can edit the text, colors, and other elements of the MOGRT file.

Here you can edit colors

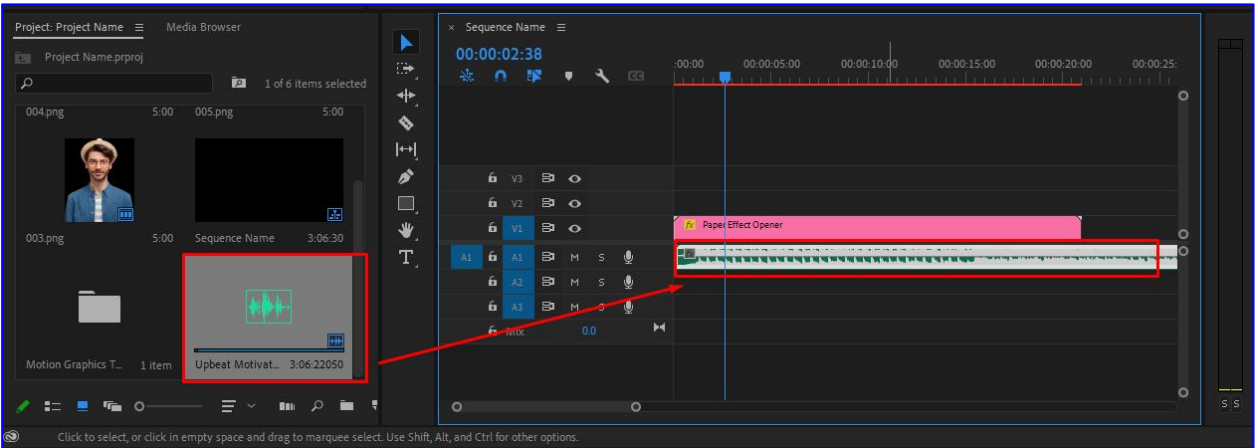


To edit photos drag your photo to “Media”.



Once you have finished editing the MOGRT file, click the Close button in the Essential Graphics window.

For import the music: Premiere Pro click on the menu option: File >Import >File (search the audio file, click on it, then click Open). Drag and drop your audio in timeline.



You can add the MOGRT file to your video, drag and drop it from the Essential Graphics panel onto your video timeline.

Once you have added the MOGRT file to your video timeline, you can edit it like any other video clip.

To export a Premiere Pro template to video, follow these steps:

Go to File > Export > Media.

In the Export Settings dialog box, select the following settings:

- Format: Select the video format that you want to export, such as MP4, MOV, or H.264.
- Preset: Select a preset that matches the settings you need for your video, such as the video resolution, frame rate, and bitrate.
- Output Name: Enter a name for your exported video file.
- Save in: Select the location where you want to save your exported video file.
- Click Export

Premiere Pro will export the template to video. The time it takes to export the video will depend on the length and complexity of the template, as well as the settings you selected.
