

# Cinematic Look User Guide

## 1. Launch Premiere Pro

Open Adobe Premiere Pro and navigate to the *Essential Graphics* panel.

## 2. Import the MOGRT Files

In the *Essential Graphics* panel, click the *Browse* tab, then select the + icon to import new MOGRT files. Add the folder named **Cinematic Look MOGRT** to your library.

## 3. Apply the Effect - Option 1

If you have a sequence with video clips on the timeline, simply drag one of the Cinematic Look MOGRT templates onto the video.

- Nest the video beneath the MOGRT by right-clicking the video clip and selecting **Nest**.
- The nested sequence will appear in your media bin. Drag this sequence into the media placeholder within the *Essential Graphics* panel.

## 4. Apply the Effect - Option 2

To convert footage directly into vintage-style video, drag the Cinematic Look MOGRT onto the timeline.

- Click on the MOGRT template, open the *Essential Graphics* panel, and replace the placeholder image with your video.

## 5. Customize the Effect

You can adjust various settings and effects in the *Essential Graphics* panel, allowing you to customize the look to suit your project needs.
